

# Swannanoa Valley Montessori School

## Tuition Schedule for 2010-2011

The Montessori teaching technique encourages students to attend five days a week. We strongly believe that each child will socialize better and learn more on a five-day schedule.

### PROGRAMS & TUITION

Early Childhood – 3 consecutive mornings (8:30 – 12:00) <i>3 year olds only</i>	\$4,050
Early Childhood – 5 mornings (8:30 – 12:00)	\$4,520
Early Childhood Afternoon Enrichment – 3 afternoons (12:00 – 2:30)	\$1,125
Early Childhood Afternoon Enrichment – 5 afternoons (12:00 – 2:30)	\$1,640
Kindergarten (8:30 – 2:30)	\$5,200
Lower Elementary – 6-9 year olds (8:30 – 2:30)	\$5,275
Upper Elementary – 9-12 year olds (8:30 – 2:30)	\$5,450

### FAMILY DISCOUNTS

There is a 10% reduction in tuition for younger siblings.

There is a 2% reduction in tuition for payment in full by August 1, 2010.

### ADDITIONAL COSTS

- \$75 non-refundable application fee
- \$200 non-refundable placement deposit fee
- \$75 materials fee, due with first tuition payment
- Field trip fee, to be determined by June 1, 2010

### VOLUNTEER TIME

SVMS requires that all families commit to at least 20 hours of volunteer work per academic year. Because your time is valuable, upon completion of volunteer time, the \$200 Placement Deposit will be refunded at the end of the school year by applying it to the last month's tuition or as a check. If you complete less than twenty hours your refund will be at a rate of \$10 per hour of time spent working.

### NOTES

Tuition is for the 2010-2011 school year and does not include summer programs, tutoring or extra testing.

The \$200 Placement Deposit will be refunded *only* if the desired class level is full. The \$75 Application Fee is non-refundable.

All children must be toileting themselves to be enrolled in SVMS.
